The Board of Directors has the authority and responsibility to:

- Develop policies, procedures, and regulations for the operation of PSM
- Monitor the PSM's financial health, programs, and overall performance
- Provide the CEO with the resources to respond to the needs of the community that PSM serves.

### QUALIFICATIONS

PSM is non-biased in its service delivery. ### LENGTH OF TERM

Board members serve an initial three-year term with optional renewal for one-year terms.
